

Dr. Pascal Braun

Dr. Pascal Braun is Group Leader at the Center for Cancer Systems Biology (CCSB) at the Dana-Farber Cancer Institute and has an appointment in the Genetics Department at Harvard Medical School, Boston. Dr. Braun's group maps protein-protein interactome networks for a number of organisms, including yeast, plants, worm and human. In addition to being involved in international interactome collaborations his group recently published a second generation map for yeast (*Science* 2008), and a method for experimental confidence scoring of individual interactions (*Nat. Methods* 2009). Dr. Braun did his PhD with Prof. Harlow at MGH working on cell cycle regulation and developing high-throughput methods for purification of proteins. During his post-doc at Harvard University he analyzed protein interactions by protein arrays and mass spectrometry.
